

Questions & Answers

1. Is this job prevailing wage?
Yes, **DAVIS-BACON PREVAILING WAGE REQUIREMENTS:** The Federal Davis-Bacon and Related Acts (“Acts”) may apply to this contract, depending on the cost of services provided. If required, interested vendors must comply with all applicable provisions of the Acts in order to be considered an eligible vendor.
2. Will this be for one facility only, or will it be part of a multi-building system?
Multi-building system.
3. Are all of the buildings tied together?
Yes. The visitation building is the only one on a separate state network.
4. How many current controllers/ Panels are connected to the network? The standalone PC that managed the Casi system is no longer operational. Based on Schematics found today 2/25 it appears that we have 6 control units.
We saw approximately 5 panels but need to confirm
5. Where are the locations of the existing panels?
They may be listed on blue prints for the buildings.
2 panels in Building C Server Room
3 panels in Building A
1 panel in Building D
6. Will we have access to those blue prints?
The vendor awarded with the contract will be given these if they are available. Schematics are available to vendors upon request prior to the proposals being due.
7. On Page 5, # 12, letter C, the statement references the printing of cards. Does Clark County have an existing card printer? If yes, can you please provide the manufacturer and model number?
Clark County does have an existing Magicard Rio printer however this printer needs replaced and should be part of your proposal.
8. Do you want tokens or badges?
The Department is currently using about 5 tokens and the rest are clamshell badges with a hole in the top.
9. Do you want to print onto a sticker or onto the badge?
The Department currently prints onto a sticker.
10. How many badges are you currently using?
The Department currently has about 208 employees and about 300 badges are issued currently
11. Is this going to be an expansion of an existing system? If so, what brand do you currently have?
This is a replacement of our Casi Rusco system. Vendor should reuse existing hardware where possible.
12. If not, do you have specific brands that you’ll consider, or are you open to any?
We do not have a specific brand requirement.
13. Is the Department looking for a surveillance camera system to be included in the quote?
A vendor has already been selected for a new camera system at the Department. The Department would like to see this and the Access Control System integrated, if possible. An Avigilon camera system was selected but has not been installed.

14. How many people will have access to the system?
About 5 will have permission and the MIS Manager will be the point of contact.
15. Do you want to use the existing panels and hardware?
Yes, the vendor should use existing panels and hardware where possible.
16. Do you want to keep the doorbell at the back of building A?
Yes
17. Would Clark County want request to exit sensors and magnetic door contacts added to all new & existing doors to make this a true access control system?
You're welcome to include that as a recommendation/optional proposal.
18. Do you want doors to be replaced?
If you think the Department needs a different door, put them in your proposal as an option.
19. If proposal includes replacement door information, will vendor receive current door finish and hardware information?
Yes
20. When was the last time keys were re-keyed?
The Department believes this hasn't been done since 1991.
21. If needed, is the vendor allowed to cut into the current doors?
Yes, if need be.
22. What does double swipe mean?
A badge reader would be on both sides of the doorway. They are needed to go in or out of the building.
23. What keyway is used?
Building A,B, and D. are a Sargent
one small area of Building B, and all of C are Schlage
24. Do you want to change the door to the MIS computer control room?
This door is planning on being replaced.
25. Do you want to use the strobes in building A?
The strobes are currently tied into the system, but they are no longer utilized.
- The proposal should include pricing for camera, printer, and badge system.
 - The Department needs a way to access the building through the building C interior entrance near the credit union during power outages
